We raise money for our Service Group to support our community by assisting where needed: Collecting Toys for Pediatric Oncology Patients, Creating Buddy Packs for Children entering Foster Care, donating food and other items to our local Animal Shelter, volunteering at the YMCA, at local Thrift Stores, and collecting for Homeless Shelters.



FRIENDSHIP GROUP & CIRCLE of FRIENDS... are two social groups, run and supported by Katie's House, that provide lots of wonderful activities in the community. To list a few... Katie's House members also gather with young adults at similar organizations, such as SMILE of Hopatcong on Tuesday evenings & Rebecca's Homestead.









EDUCATION... LACE (Learning at College Experience) is a program at Sussex County Community College. Although not run by Katie's House, most of our Residents and many Friendship Group and Circle of Friends members attend this weekly program that runs September through May. Students attend with their DSP and learn skills and topics according to their abilities. LACE is also a wonderful social opportunity for young people to get together with peers.
