Your donations keep this going. Love you Katie



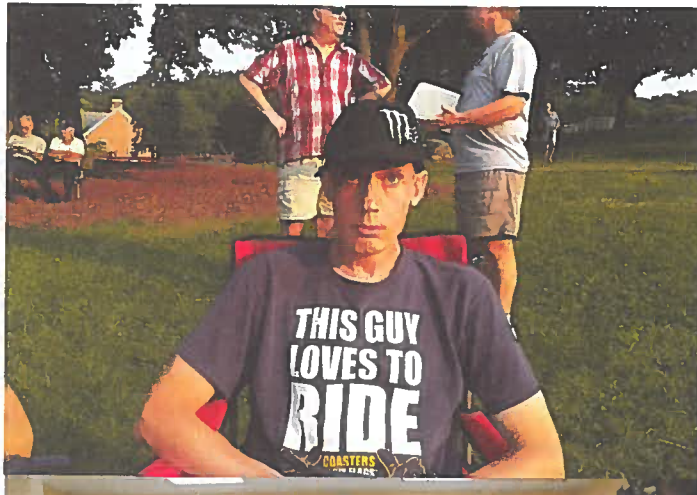
Center For Advancement

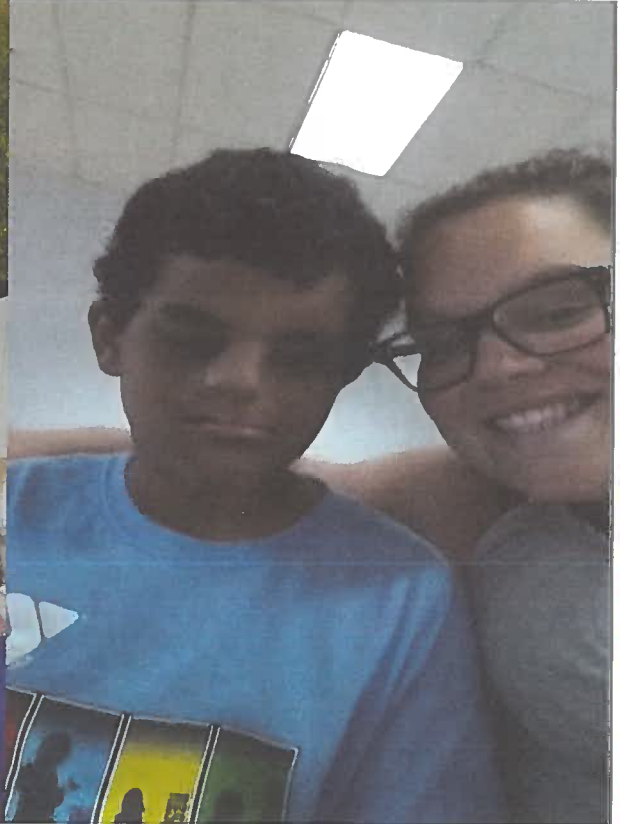
